### TICKETS TO GO ON SALE FOR OUTBACK BUSINESSES NIGHT OF NIGHTS

Tickets for the 2017 Northern Outback Business Awards are set to go on sale this Friday September 1st, with organisers forecasting a sell out.

“With close to 30 different award categories we have already received multiple nominations for each which is very good news” said President, Travis Crowther.

“With the old saying of having to be in it to win it very fitting, we really encourage people to get in and nominate; even self-nominate to ensure they or their favourite businesses can receive the recognition that winning Northern Outback Business Awards can bring.”





An evening also renowned for its secret themes and entertainment Travis and his team were tight lipped about what to expect on the night, but did confirm “a fire-flair bartender” will be featured; serving up an array of cocktails for guests to purchase!

Tickets for the 2017 Northern Outback Business Awards will be available from the Mount Isa Civic Centre box office from 9am this Friday for \$110 per person and will include a 3-course meal, complimentary red and white table wine and all entertainment.
